

# The Watchman (Ez33)

1. **Proclaim:** Sound the Trumpet (v1-9)
2. **Pray:** Turn, Turn! (v10-20)
3. **Persevere:** A Prophet Among Them  
(v30-33)

his **blood** shall be upon his own head.



but they will **not do** it.



Is he not a maker of **parables?**”


